Important change to Capital Gains Tax from April 6th 2020

There have been significant changes to Capital Gains Tax from 6 April 2020. One of these changes is that if you sell a residential property that is not your main home you will need to report and pay any potential capital gains tax **within 60 days**.

If you are hoping to sell a residential property that is not your main home within the next 12 months please let us know so that we can set up the reporting requirements in advance for you, and discuss any options to mitigate the tax liability.
